The Dr. Phillips Center for the Performing Arts is a newly constructed cast-in-place concrete and structural steel structure. The 263,000-square-foot facility features the 2,700-seat Walt Disney Theater and the 300-seat Alexis & Jim Pugh Theater, the School for the Arts which brings arts education to students of any age. Here are more numbers that make up this impressive facility.



- 1 Nearly 2,000,000 pounds of steel in the iconic canopy. **That spans the length of a football field**
- 2 The final beam was **70 feet long** and weighed over **10,000 pounds**
- 3 Used **\$3 Million** in recyclable materials and **\$4 Million** in Regional Materials
- 4 Digital plan rooms with over **10,000 electronic files** accessed by iPads in the field
- 5 **\$36 Million** in contracts awarded to minority and woman-owned firms
- 6 **Over 1,500,000 man-hours without a lost-time accident**
